Willitoft Fishery Rules & Tariff

Adults £8, children £6

- Under 16s must be accompanied by an Adult at all times
- Barbless hooks only, maximum size 12
- No carp/specimen rods, no bite alarms, no boilies
- No dogs, no night fishing
- No litter, including cigarette ends, to be left any where around the lakes. No bins on site please take your litter home
- Do not throw left over bait into or around the lakes
- Free running feeders & bombs only, no elasticated, no stops/beads knots above
- Please remember this is my family home and we have holidaying guests staying regularly in the cabin and bungalow so please keep your language respectful
- No surface fishing, no floating feed
- NO! Meat, Bread, bloodworm, trout pellets & artificial baits (wafters, mussels, prawns, cockles allowed)
- Keep nets only allowed in match's
- Keep net limits per net: 60lb, between 60lb-66lb goes back to 60lb, over 66lb net disqualification

High Lake

- · Separate net for silvers & carp to 2lb 'ish
- Any silvers in with large carp net will be disqualified
- Keep nets must be dry before you arrive at the fishery then laid out immediately behind your peg and only put in the water 15 minutes before your match starts
- •No floating pole, pole limit 16m
- No cupping in with the pole when other rods in use!
- Mugging allowed but you must remain seated
- Minimum lash of 4 inches from pole tip to float tip
- Minimum depth from float tip to hook 6 inches
- Floats must be in the water, do not suspend baits on the surface, no free lining
- No tapping pole tips or cupping pots on the water
- No potting in water
- No gardening! Small amount of grass trimming permitted only, do not touch branches or reeds without permission
- Fishing from designated platforms only
- Please wash your platforms down to remove as much spilled bait as possible
- Anyone disregarding these rules will be disqualified and or asked to leave the fishery
